## Landing Page

- Hamburger menu
  - PW icon: closes the menu and takes user to the landing page
  - User's name
  - Parking passes: Previous bookings and upcoming passes
  - Account Settings: Add/ change payment and vehicle. Sign out from the app
  - Call: For calling, texting and emailing, only one tap is required. After tapping on any of these, user directly can contact ParkWhiz without getting directed to another page.
  - Text
  - Email
  - FAQ: This is called "Visit support page" on the app. It is mostly FAQs with a lot of detailed information. Maybe need to narrow it down a little and change "Visit support page" to FAQ? Might help reduce customer service calls if we enable users find the answer of their questions easily?
  - Write review/ Sharing
  - Roadside assistance: includes several items for the type of problem.
- Searchbar - Address
  - Current location
  - History: How history is different from Recent locations?
  - Recent Locations
  - Popular venues
    - List of events
    - Not looking for an event?
- Start & end time sliders (Has a bug)
- Start & end date pickers (Has a bug)

## Booking Page

- Main picture
- Price
- Address
- Parking name
- Price: This price is like a text bubble. Is there any reason for having 2 prices in a page?
- Booking button
- Rating
- Location description
- More images
- Amenities
- Starting and ending date and time: Called "Pass details"
- Payment: Total price. Change/add card (This doesn't have discount option like android. It decreases the price automatically once the user clicks on the spot)
- Booking button

## Android

### Landing Page

- Modal
  - Searchbar- address
  - Starting & ending time sliders
  - Starting & ending date pickers: These also have a separate modal for setting time (has a bug)
- Address, time and date: This opens the modal again
- Hamburger menu
  - Parkwhiz icon: Unlike iOS, ParkWhiz text is not clickable (Only the icon next to the text is clickable for closing the menu).
  - Searchbar: Opens the modal for address and date and time.
  - Parking passess: includes previous and current passses

- Account setting: Name, email address and phone number. Reset password. Add/change payment and vehicle.
- Write review/ Share
- Contact: Modal showing text message and call options. (This cannot be closed easily)
- Help: Redundant since most options already includes in hamburger menu
  - Contact ParkWhiz by phone
  - Contact ParkWhiz by email
  - FQA
  - About parkwhiz
- Roadside assistance
- Settings: Application's setting for notifications.
- Search button: This is redundant. Opens modal the same as address bar.

Content	Explanation
<b>Landing page</b>	
Searchbar and time sliders	Similar to web this is primary call to action (For web there is a searchbar and button)
Parking passing	This is called "Parking History" on web
account setting	Includes names, email, phone number, reset password on web
Contact	This is in the footer
FQA	Is on the dropdown menu as well. It is called "Help" in mobile web
Share	There is no Share option on web
Roadside assistance	There is no Roadside assistance on the web.
History and Recent locations	These don't exist on web
Date and time	There is a bar on the web that when it's being taped on, it shows a modal that includes time slider and date picker. (This is not on landing page)
Map	There is no map on the web
<b>Booking page</b>	
Main picture	Is not appropriate size on web
Price	Is on the Booking button on web
Address and parking name	Parking name is shown on the list view. Only address in on Booking page
Rating and amenities	These are under the address
Location Description and more images	Unlike apps, pictures come first and location description is after them

Starting and ending date and time	At the top of the page there is a box for editing date and time that opens a modal
Payment	<a href="#">Payment info is on the checkout page</a>
